Modesto is comfortable, casual town looking forward to hosting the District 21 regional. The regional is at Modesto Center Plaza, a beautiful facility. It is in the center of Modesto, where a plethora of exciting activities are quite close by. Most likely you will have so much fun playing bridge you won't want to do anything else, but just in case you need a break, here are some of your choices.

Across from the main entrance of the plaza is a pedestrian mall with small restaurants and bistros and a large 17 screen Cineplex. This is the usual big movie theater with first run movies.



At the end of this one block mall is J street made famous by American Graffiti. Within half a block or so on J street you will find other restaurants including two of Modesto's finest Galletto and Tresetti's as well as the historic State Theater. The State (yes, American Graffiti, again) is completely restored and features classic and independent films as well as performing arts.

Exactly two (easy walking) blocks away is the [Gallo Center for the Performing Arts](#), their state of the art theaters draw audiences from all over the San Joaquin Valley. Performers rave about the acoustics and advanced design of the two theaters. They have booked a wide range of performances from Tony Bennett to Peter Frampton to Linda Ronstadt, classical music of all kinds, many comedians, including Bob Newhart and Jay Leno, touring Broadway shows and even acrobats.



Within a short driving distance is the historic McHenry Mansion. The town home of one of the town's founders. This is beautifully restored Victorian offers tours Sunday to Friday.
