Bridge Tip of the day

There is one trick at bridge that is more important than the rest. Can you guess which it is?

That's right, trick one! This is the moment where you gain the most information about the hand. The dummy is revealed, and so is the opening lead and the cards played to it.

One of the most common mistakes players make is not paying enough attention at trick one. The cards played will tell you a story, if you are willing to put in the effort to understand it.

Take this example:

You are declaring 3NT after the auction 1NT - Pass - 3NT- All Pass.

A 5 3
7 2
A J T 3
Q 9 5 3

T 4
A K Q J
Q 9 8 2
K J T

Your left-hand opponent leads a spade. You choose to duck two rounds and win the third round. Now how should you come to nine tricks?

You have two possible lines of play to consider. You could knock out the Ace of Clubs and hope the opponents don't have 2 more spades to cash, or you could take a diamond finesse and hope that it wins. Which line is correct?

Answer: I hope you were watching the spades your opponents were playing! If your LHO led the s2, chances are high that the spades are 4-4 and you do not need to risk the diamond finesse. If your LHO led the s6 and followed with the s2, chances are that he led 4th best from a 5-card suit, and this means that RHO is now out of spades.

In this case, the diamond finesse is your best chance, as even if it loses your RHO will be out of spades and you will make the hand if LHO has dK or RHO has both dK and cA.

However, if you weren't paying attention at trick 1, you will have no clues to guide you to the winning line!

There are many other times, as declarer and defender, that trick 1 contains vital information if you just remember to pay attention.

So, my pro tip is:

Pay close attention to trick 1!
